I would just like to say a huge 'WELL DONE' to our Y6 children for all the hard work and effort they have put into their studies this year. The year 6 SATs results were released on Tuesday and I am delighted to say that all of our pupils achieved the expected standard in all subjects—Reading, Writing, SPAG (spellings, punctuation and grammar) and Maths, with many of our pupils also achieving at a higher level. This gives us a 100% achievement rate, compared to 63% nationally, putting Bishop Hooper in the top 10% of schools!

In addition, our Y2 pupils have achieved well above the national average in their SATs and the Y1 pupils have achieved well above the national average in their phonics tests.

I am delighted with such an outstanding set of results and would like to say thank you to both all of our children for their efforts and all of our staff for their continued hard work and commitment in all year groups. There should be some excellent school reports coming home at the end of term!

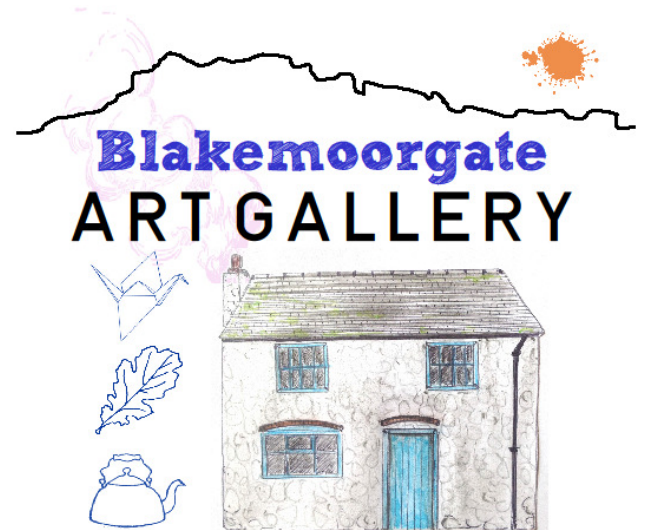
