

Latest Key Stage 2 Attainment and Progress Measures (Age 11) July 2016



In July 2016, the new more challenging curriculum was assessed for the first time by new tests. Results are no longer reported as levels and, due to these changes, only 53% pupils nationally reached the new expected standard in reading, writing and mathematics. Due to these changes, the Department for Education have stated that '...figures for 2016 are not comparable to those for earlier years. The expectations for pupils at the end of key stage 2 have been raised.'

As you can see from the following data, our pupils and staff worked extremely hard last year and with good results, achieving higher than the average Shropshire school in Maths, Spelling Punctuation and Grammar and Writing.
