Our school is committed to supporting Fairtrade wherever possible. Fairtrade is about guaranteeing a better deal for Fairtrade farmers and producers in developing countries who grow the things we eat and use every day.

Bishop Hooper School will:

1. Make sure Fairtrade is a topic in at least three subject areas, across Year groups 1-6 and will hold a Fairtrade assembly each term.
2. Ensure Fairtrade is part of the School Development Plan.
3. Use Fairtrade products wherever possible:
 - Tea and coffee in the staffroom and at meetings and at 'Friends' events.
 - In cookery activities
 - In the dining hall
4. Visit a local shop, market stall and café selling/serving Fairtrade products or invite a local Traidcraft Fairtrader to come into school with Traidcraft products for sale.
5. Hold a Fairtrade Cookery club on a regular basis
