# News from the classrooms

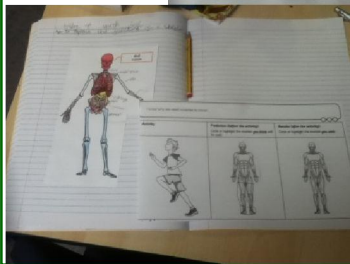
**CLASS 1** The children have been using single digit number cards to generate number sentences and calculated the answers using counting bears to help them.
