Dear Parent or Carer

As you may have heard in the media, today is 'National Safer Internet Day'. All of our pupils have participated in an E-Safety assembly today and have been involved in lots of different E-safety activities in their classrooms. As most children now access the Internet at home, as well as at school, we feel it is extremely important that we continue to work together as a school community to ensure they stay safe on line.

On National Safer Internet Day last year, we sent home 'Acceptable Use Policies' (AUPs) for children to sign and return to school to show they understand the basic rules of staying safe on the Internet. Our staff and Governors feel strongly that this should now be repeated every year at this time, to ensure that E-Safety remains a priority both at school and at home.

Each pupil has received 2 copies of an AUP. One copy needs to be signed and returned to school by Friday 13<sup>th</sup> February, to be kept on file and the other is for you to keep at home. There is space for parents to sign, to show that you have read and discussed the Internet safety rules with your child. In addition there is another letter, 'school policy and procedure with regards to Internet use', which we ask parents to complete and return to school.
