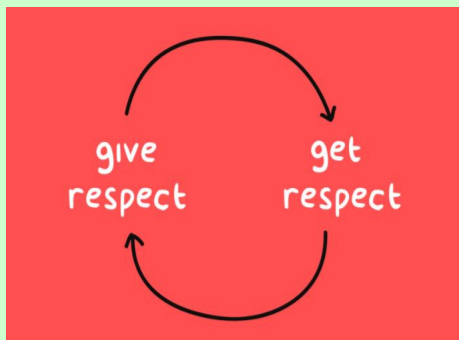
Congratulations to Mortimer House who were our House Point winners this week.

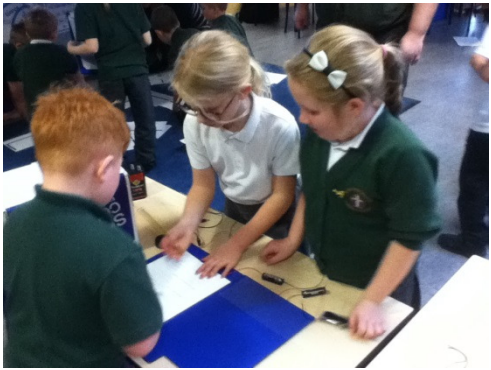
